1. Introduction to the Program

It is an important section that collects, analyses and records various academic information of the campus. Collecting, analyzing and recording academic data are crucial for every institution, for they help in taking right and prompt decision. This section, in addition, makes the academic data available to the stakeholders whenever necessary.

The progress and success of the campus largely depends on the effective performance of EMIS section. Inefficiency of this section affects the public trust over the campus, which ultimately results in the downfall of the institution. Therefore, in order to keep records of the academic data systematically and to make the academic system effective, the EMIS staff should be made efficient.

7. Achievement and Outcome of the Training

The training program has developed skills and updated knowledge regarding information system in the participants. The information shared in this program has helped the participants be acquainted with cyber security. It has also helped them collect, analyze and record the data systematically. The positive impact of their performance is expected to be observed in the overall academia of this region.

8. Future Perspectives and Challenges

In the present day, the importance of EMIS is ever growing. However, it is seen that in most of the campuses, the proper documentation of the files has not been done. Most of the staffs of different campus are even unaware of cyber security and network functioning. Although this program has helped imparting knowledge and skill in this field to some extent, a lot of effort is still required to develop a culture of managing information system. Mahakavi Devkota perceives that a few more related trainings and workshop will encourage the educational institutions of this area to install EMIS software and develop the practice of proper recording, analyzing and documenting the data.

EMIS Capacity Development Training is a step towards acquainting EMIS staffs and faculties with current and possible future problems and possibilities related to information system. The trainees are expected to apply the knowledge in their respective institutions. Although the training remained significant, the following challenges still persist:

- Any training program of 3 days can give a general concept of the information technology; however, it cannot give a detailed knowledge and skills related to the field. Moreover, the regular practice of the individuals largely depends on the meaningful outcome of the program.
- Most of the public institutions that do not have additional funding source may find it expensive to purchase and install EMIS software.

9. Conclusion and Recommendation

EMIS Capacity Development Training program was conducted by Mahakavi Devkota Campus with the support of UGC Nepal in a techno-friendly environment. Theoretical as well as practical lessons were discussed and practiced in the program. Experiences related to



information system were shared among the participants and facilitators. Participants felt the significance these lessons and skills on their workplaces. Some of these skills turned out to be heard-but-less practiced and useful ones for most of the participants. However, following recommendations are made.

- Since the activities in EMIS are more a matter of practice and up-to-datedness rather than learnt-and-followed, the regular trainings and experience sharing is necessary.
- EMIS trainings often focus of recording, analyzing and documenting of the academic data in digital form or soft copies. Moreover, these trainings also inform and educate about cyber security. Yet, the threats of data hacking and cybercrime still persist. Therefore, it would be better if these sorts of programs equally encourage EMIS staffs to keep hard copies of every academic data.




- Audience The audience is defined as the group or segment of the population you are designing for.

- Many factors need to be taken into consideration when developing a design such as age, background, skills & abilities, and cultural differences.

General Audience Rules

Good Visual Design Will Help You Stand Out From The Crowd



- Age makes a difference: younger and older readers require larger print.
- Make sure there is a good visual separation between the words and background; avoid dark or very bright colors, avoid complicated backgrounds such as patterns.
- Reading skills influence design, keep page layouts simple.
- Remember, you are not designing for yourself, you are designing for your audience!



General Layout Rules

- The layout is defined as the planned organization of text, colors, and images on a page or screen.
- Many factors need to be taken into consideration when developing a layout including font size, color palettes, column width(s), image types and image sizes.




- Be consistent; help the reader recognize, identify, and comprehend different types of information.
- “I like it.” is not a reason to include it in your design. Logic, clarity, and meaning should drive the design.
- Keep it simple; only include layout elements, images and words that support the message.



Typography

- Typography is the design and use of typefaces [fonts] as a means of visual communication from calligraphy to the ever-developing use of digital type.




General Typography Rules

- Avoid using more than two different type families (fonts) in one project.
- Add contrast by using one typeface (font) with two different styles; e.g., use a light or regular weight with a bold or extra-bold weighted font.
- NEVER use all caps for writing paragraphs.





General Image Rules




- Use graphics and images to break up the layout so that the reader has opportunities to absorb information.
- Be careful that the images used can be reproduced without losing resolution! (Don't use blurry pictures!)
- Cropping, or removing the unwanted parts of an image, allows you to focus on the important parts of that picture.
- Be sure your pictures have meaning and support the message you are trying to convey!
- Brightness is the total amount of light in an image. Change the brightness of an image to change its appearance.




Color

- Color is the set of colors or color palette chosen to enhance, compliment, and impact the final outcome of the design.
- Color plays a vital role in how your audience perceives, reacts to, and ultimately understands your message.



General Color Rules

- Hue is the actual name for color.
- Colors can suggest temperature. Reds, oranges, browns and yellows suggest warmth; blues, greens and purples suggest coolness.
- Warm colors appear larger than cool colors.



- Most colors carry emotional and psychological implications.
- Saturation is the intensity or boldness of a color.
- Gradients – the degree of change from one color into another – creates a 3D effect.

Resolution requirements for print output

- Resolution** is defined as the degree of sharpness of a computer-generated image as measured by the number of dots per linear inch in a hard-copy printout or the number of pixels across and down on a display screen.
- Anything being designed for print output needs to have a minimum resolution of 150 DPI or PPI. The higher the resolution, the sharper the printed image will be.



WordPress





- WordPress is an open source Content Management System (CMS), which allows the users to build dynamic websites and blogs.
- WordPress is the most popular blogging system on the web and allows updating, customizing and managing the website from its back-end CMS and components.

What is Content Management System (CMS)?

- The Content Management System (CMS) is a software which stores all the data such as text, photos, music, documents, etc. and is made available on your website.
- It helps in editing, publishing and modifying the content of the website.
- WordPress was initially released on 27th May, 2003 by Matt Mullenweg and Mike Little. WordPress was announced as open source in October 2009.

Features

- User Management: It allows managing the user information such as changing the role of the users to (subscriber, contributor, author, editor or administrator), create or delete the user, change the password and user information. The main role of the user manager is Authentication.
- Media Management: It is the tool for managing the media files and folder, in which you can easily upload, organize and manage the media files on your website.
- Theme System: It allows modifying the site view and functionality. It includes images, stylesheet, template files and custom pages.

- Extend with Plugins: Several plugins are available which provides custom functions and features according to the users need.
- Search Engine Optimization: It provides several search engine optimization (SEO) tools which makes on-site SEO simple.
- Multilingual: It allows translating the entire content into the language preferred by the user.
- Importers: It allows importing data in the form of posts. It imports custom files, comments, post pages and tags.

Advantages

- It is an open source platform and available for free.
- CSS files can be modified according to the design as per users need.
- There are many plugins and templates available for free. Users can customize the various plugins as per their need.
- It is very easy to edit the content as it uses WYSIWYG editor (What You See Is What You Get is a user interface that allows the user to directly manipulate the layout of document without having a layout command).

- Media files can be uploaded easily and quickly.
- It offers several SEO tools which makes on-site SEO simple.
- Customization is easy according to the user's needs.
- It allows creating different roles for users for website such as admin, author, editor and contributor.

Disadvantages

- Using several plugins can make the website heavy to load and run.
- PHP knowledge is required to make modifications or changes in the WordPress website.
- Sometimes software needs to be updated to keep the WordPress up-to-date with the current browsers and mobile devices. Updating WordPress version leads to loss of data, so it a backup copy of the website is required.
- Modifying and formatting the graphic images and tables is difficult.
